

Des Moines Skydivers A-License Training Program

Terms and Conditions

- I understand that I will be required to sign a "Release of liability and agreement" waiver before I am allowed to participate in skydiving activities at Des Moines Skydivers LLC.
- I understand that I must be at least 18 years old and weigh 220lbs or less on the day of my first skydive.
- I understand that in order to achieve my A-License in a timely fashion, I need to be at the dropzone one full-day per week on average.
- I understand that even though I am at the dropzone, I may not get to jump due to weather conditions.
- I understand that during the course of my training, the estimated cost to achieve my A-license is at least \$2,500 and typically not more than \$3,000. This amount is spread throughout your training (4-12 weeks).
- I understand that I will be encouraged to purchase my own gear by the time I am licensed or shortly thereafter. (We have rental gear but newer students get priority)
- I understand that it is not a guarantee that I will achieve my A-License within 25 jumps and that repeat jumps may be necessary as required to complete the A-License check list.
- I understand that I will be required to purchase a logbook and goggles for \$25
- I understand that am not allowed to jump with a camera until I have reached 200 skydives.
- I understand that the parachute, jumpsuit, helmet and other necessary equipment will be provided to me during my AFF training.
- I understand that I'm strongly encouraged to read the "<u>How It Works</u>" and "<u>FAQ</u>" sections of <u>www.desmoinesskydivers.com</u> to become acquainted with the training method and costs associated with learning to skydive.
